

INFORMATION NOTICE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 and the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) and on the basis of the information clause below. In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (OJ EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016 – GDPR), the Medical University of Gdańsk hereby informs you that:

1. The controller of your personal data is the Medical University of Gdańsk, ul. M. Curie-Skłodowskiej 3a, 80-210 Gdańsk.
2. The controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at the following email address: iod@gumed.edu.pl.
3. Your personal data will be processed in connection with the implementation of the project “Strengthening the institutional capacity of GUMed through cooperation in the ACE2-EU European University Alliance” – the “ACE2-EU Language Tandems” task, funded by the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange (NAWA), for the following purposes and on the following grounds:
 - a) for the purpose of conducting the recruitment process for the project and, in the event of participation in the project, for the purpose of delivering the educational programme; the legal basis for processing in this case is Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR (performance of a task carried out in the public interest);
 - b) for the purpose of potentially establishing, pursuing or defending against claims arising in connection with recruitment and participation in the project; the basis for processing in this case is Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, i.e. the legitimate interests of the Controller.
4. Personal data will be processed to the extent of the data contained in the recruitment form, and in the event of qualification for participation – to the extent of the data necessary for participation in the project.
5. As a general rule, the Medical University of Gdańsk does not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area. In the event of participation in activities related to the study or teaching of the Macedonian language, personal data may be transferred to recipients in North Macedonia. This country is not covered by the European Commission’s decision establishing an adequate level of protection for personal data; therefore, the transfer of data will take place exclusively through one of the mechanisms provided for in Chapter V of the GDPR, in particular standard contractual clauses or – in

cases provided for by law – on the basis of the exception set out in Article 49 of the GDPR.

6. You have the right to access your personal data, as well as the right to rectify, erase, restrict the processing of, and object to the processing of your data.

7. The recipients of your personal data may include public authorities or other entities authorised by law, as well as entities providing services to the Controller with whom data processing agreements have been concluded. Your personal data may also be shared with other project participants (natural persons) – solely to the extent covered by your consent to participate in the project, for the purpose of establishing contact and carrying out cooperation within the language tandem.

8. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling processes.

9. The provision of personal data is voluntary; however, failure to provide it may result in the inability to participate in the project.

10. Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the project and until any claims by the parties become time-barred in accordance with the law.

11. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection – if you consider that the processing of personal data infringes the provisions of the GDPR.

CONSENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROJECT

I consent to participating in the project “Strengthening the institutional capacity of the Medical University of Gdańsk through cooperation within the ACE2-EU European University Alliance” – the “ACE2-EU Language Tandems” task.

I acknowledge that participation in the project involves sharing my details (first name, email address) with another participant (Learner/Language Coach) for the purpose of establishing contact and collaborating within the language tandem.

I understand that participation in the project is voluntary, but the sharing of data is a condition of participation. Withdrawal of consent at any time will result in the termination of my participation in the project and the deletion of my personal data by the organiser, subject to the retention of data necessary to demonstrate the lawfulness of the processing.
